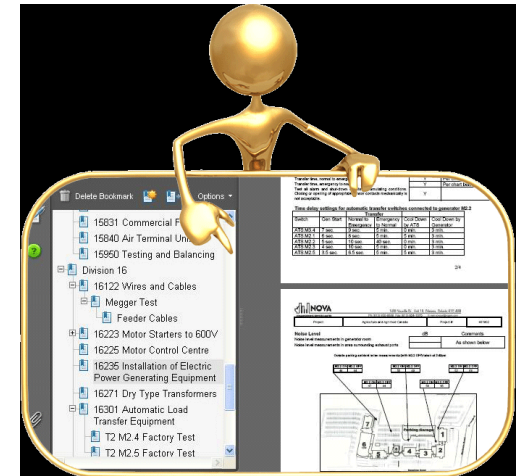

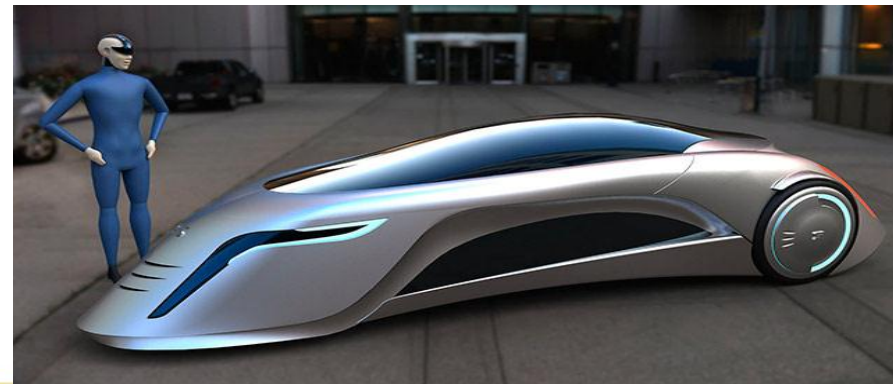
What is DATEX II?

- DATEX II is an organisation to support the exchange of traffic and travel data in a standardised way!
- Organisation



History of DATEX II

- **Datex 1.2 (a?)**
- **MoU on DATEX 1**
- **Maintained by TC and SC**
- **Need to do something: split content from technology and standardise xml/webservice exchange**
- **Tender for DATEX II by EU (2003)**
- **DATEX II version 1 in december 2006**
- **And then: no Easyway, no EU organisation, or....**
 - DATEX II grant
 - Volunteering countries
- **In 2008 Easyway umbrella**
- **After Easyway ends?**



DATEX II is maintained by EasyWay Study 5 DATEX II and standardised by CEN TC 278

The decisive body on maintenance of DATEX II is the Strategic Group of EasyWay Study 5 (SG).

- Each member state participating in EasyWay can participate in the SG.
- Each participating member state has one vote.

The SG is supported by a Technical Group (TG)

- TG work item 2 (WI-2) *Change control and Release management is responsible for carrying out the process as described in the Rules of Procedure (RoP).*
- review all proposals on changes and amendments and all extensions that are uploaded on the DATEX II website
- Review Report, including an expert advice to the SG whether the new topic could be added to DATEX II

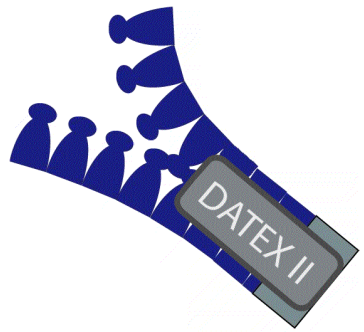

- **Everything affecting standardised parts results in a Major release**
- **Everything else results in a Minor release**
 - Extensions
 - Profiles
 - Supporting documentation

- **Version 2.1 will be released soon**
 - Parking extention
 - Bugfixes in documentation, not affecting the datamodel
- **Active workitems**
 - Exchange
 - Provide information
 - Support transactions
 - Measured and elaborated data (CEN)
 - Traffic Managment Plans support
 - In navigation (planned)
 - Interoperability with TPEG
- **Indicative Release schedule**
 - Major releases every 3 to 5 years, aiming at CEN standardisation
 - Minor releases every year
 - Subversions – 2 per year (bug fixing only)
